COISCÉIM DANCE THEATRE

In residence

CoisCéim's residency at St Patrick's College is now in its third year and runs from October 2015 to June 2016. Working with the Physical Education Unit, the company will lead a range of dynamic initiatives for students, to develop their experience of dance as a performing art form and a creative learning activity.

CoisCéim Dance Theatre is one of Ireland's leading dance companies. Founded in 1995, CoisCéim's style of performance is contemporary and vibrant, with a knowing regard for the everyday. Artistic Director David Bolger embraces a selection of dance styles to articulate stories and emotions that are relevant to the landscapes in which we live. The scale of the company's work ranges from duets in a hotel bedroom, Chamber Made, to the large scale spectacle, A Dash of Colour (which was seen by millions on television and involved over 75,000 people for the opening ceremony of the Special Olympics, 2003). National and international touring are a key element of the company's work. CoisCéim performs regularly on the international stage, especially in the United States and at festivals such as the Edinburgh Festival Fringe where it has won 2 Fringe Firsts. At home, the company works with many communities of varying age, ability and location through its participation and engagement programme - Broadreach.

TEACHER EDUCATION

An introduction to creative dance

This strand of the residency provides a basic cognitive understanding of creative dance. Taking a cross-curricular approach, students will gain practical experience in developing themes and ideas, knowledge of key choreographic concepts, and some relevant tools to teach dance to primary school children.



Prokofiev's PETER AND THE WOLF is one of the most famous pieces of music ever written. The classic story has been interpreted by many artists from Disney to the Marx Brothers and won a Grammy award for Bill Clinton, Mikhail Gorbachov and Sofia Loren

CoisCéim takes this timeless story of courage and imagination as inspiration for its forthcoming work to be premiered this autumn, and here... the story is told through the eyes of a WOLF. Filled with dance and live music, this energetic, fun and richly theatrical production by David Bolger gives life to a Bird, a Cat, a Duck, a Boy, and of course a Wolf. THE WOLF AND PETER will take audiences on a thrilling adventure to explore and discover contemporary dance and performance at its best.



BROADREACH | CREATIVE DANCE TALESSupported by The Ireland Funds

In parallel with THE WOLF AND PETER, the company is piloting a nation-wide series of workshops, CREATIVE DANCE TALES. This initiative aims to deepen children's understanding of dance and storytelling through movement. These imaginative and lively sessions will offer 6 - 10 year olds a kinaesthetic learning experience in creative dance. This experience is linked to the Primary School Curriculum where children are encouraged to look at and respond to dance, art, music and drama. This pilot phase also includes two specialist workshops for educators as well as 28 workshops in 10 primary schools across Ireland.

At St Patrick's College CREATIVE DANCE TALES workshops will be held for 4^{th} Year Students and teachers from the Irish Primary PE Teachers Association.

TALKING DANCE | DANCE ON FILM with Choreographer David Bolger

In 2001, CoisCéim was the first dance company to receive funding from The Irish Film Board for the dark, edgy dance film coproduction, HIT AND RUN. David Bolger will talk about creating choreography for film followed by a screening of extracts from HIT AND RUN.
