

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

A very warm welcome to CoisCéim Dance Theatre's studio here in Fairview. We are delighted to have you here with us for GO TO BLAZES - part of Ulysses 2.2. This evening's show is a mix of Live and 180° Virtual Reality performance. It is an artistic response to Episode 4 - Calypso.

When starting to research the text I realised just how much of *Ulysses* is in our DNA. Joyce's writing captures so much of the city and its people. I was also struck by how affected I was reading Calypso. In the household of 7 Eccles Street in which the episode takes place, I found so many contemporary references in Joyce's multi-layered storytelling coupled with tantalisingly teasing references to Homer's Odyssey. His great way of writing the inner and outer thoughts of his characters.

I kept coming back to the scene between Leopold Bloom and Molly Bloom in the bedroom – he has just returned from the butchers and has fixed her breakfast on the humpy tray. Molly asks Leopold to explain *Metempsychosis* – a word from a book she is reading which she doesn't understand. Leopold describes it as the transmigration of souls from the Greek. Or reincarnation. This gave me an anchor in the text and a way into how I might respond.

This evening's work involves three exquisite performers and many world-class artists from sound, projection, light, scent, costume, props, design and film – including the street you walked on your way to the studio. The creation of GO TO BLAZES has been a consummate team effort and we hope you enjoy the experience!
